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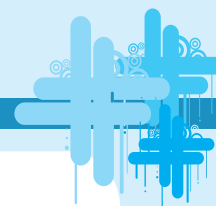


Student Council :

- The school encourages children to be independent and inculcate a sense of self-discipline and self-governance by appointing a Student Council from Grade VI.
 - The students are given the freedom to elect their representatives through online voting system on the election day.
- The students are divided into four houses:

Sapphire	- Blue
Emerald	- Green
Ruby	- Red
Coral	- Yellow

- The Student Council consists of a Head Girl and a Head Boy who represents the students in decision making regarding students' affairs. They are assisted by Captains and Vice Captains of the four houses.
- The Investiture Ceremony is held in the beginning of the academic year after the formal election of the Student Council.
- Grade Monitors, Assistant Monitors and Volunteers also form an integral part of Student Council.
- All competitions are conducted house wise.
- House points are announced every month.
- "House Cup" is awarded to the house with maximum points at the end of the academic year.



GENERAL INFORMATION

Admission:

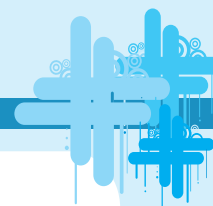
- New admissions are subject to vacancies. No correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.
- The Principal has absolute right over admission of a child to the school and decision of the Principal shall be final and binding on the parents.
- Parents seeking admission for their ward in Grade I shall submit an official Birth Certificate from the Municipal Corporation or Gram Panchayat in support of the date of birth entered in the Registration Form, a copy of Aadhar Card and also Caste Certificate if any.
- All children seeking admission in Grade II and above shall submit original School Leaving Certificate, a copy of Aadhar Card and also Caste Certificate if any.
- The records will be maintained as per the school LC/ Birth Certificate.
- Any change in the record can be made if a proper Affidavit or Gazette copy is submitted to the school.
- A child coming from another state shall get the School Leaving Certificate counter signed from the Competitive Authority of the Education Department.
- Parents shall submit a copy of their wards' progress report during admission.
- The school does not entertain anyone influencing the school authority / staff / others, in kind, for securing admission.

Withdrawal:

- In case of withdrawal of admission, parents will have to fill the form, given in the school almanac (Page No.95) along with a written application addressed to the Principal.
- Parents have to ensure that the written application for Leaving Certificate should be submitted in person to the admission counselling dept (Room no 207- 2nd floor) a month before the actual date of withdrawal or as per details given through circular, failing which, the fee will have to be paid as mentioned in the circular.

Fees:

- All fees are to be paid for 12 months.
- Fees are to be paid in three installments.
- First Installment during admission or on result day (March or April) along with Post Dated Cheques for Second and Third Installment
- Cheques issued are subject to realization.
- Overwriting on cheques is not permitted.
- Non-CTS cheque or outstation cheques will not be accepted.
- Parents have the option to pay the fees for the whole year also.
- **Parents should carry the fee card while paying the fees.**
- Fees should be deposited through local cheques in favour of '**New Horizon Scholars School**. Please mention **Name, Grade, Division, GR. No., and Contact No.** on the reverse side of the cheque.
- Please note that, payment of fees on time, is mandatory.
- **Fees once paid, are neither refundable nor transferable.**



Dress Code:

- Parents should ensure that their ward comes neatly dressed to school with the ID Card and maintains good personal hygiene.
- Pattern and colour of the school uniform shall be available in the school.
- **Pupils shall wear House Uniform and black canvas shoes on the Activity Day & Yoga Period.**
- Fancy chains, bracelets, ear rings and wrist watches are not allowed. If found, it will be confiscated.
- Earrings (for girls) : Only studs are allowed (For safety during play).
- **Girl students should wear short black slacks everyday and long black slacks compulsory for P.E., Yoga and Dance Practice Sessions.**

Hair:

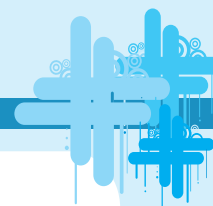
- Boys should have simple and short hair. Hair should not fall on the forehead and ears.
- No fancy hair cut or hair style is allowed.
- Girls with long hair below shoulder level shall tie two plain plaits with white ribbons.
- Girls with short hair above shoulder level shall wear white hair bands.
- No fancy hair bands, clips and hair pins are allowed.
- Turban, if worn, should be white in colour.
- Colouring of hair is not allowed.

Cleanliness:

- Pupils shall value cleanliness on priority.
- All the pupils should be fully aware of personal hygiene.
- Pupils should cut their nails regularly and keep them clean. Students should not do any nail art.
- Pupils should be careful not to throw any papers, chocolate wrappers, fruit seeds, etc. anywhere in the school premises and help in keeping the school surroundings clean.

Discipline:

- Students need to be aware that with every opportunity comes responsibility which can be practised if he / she is self-disciplined.
- The children will be encouraged to take responsibility for their action with corrective measures by the teachers. The teacher's efforts would be effective only with positive inputs and support from the parents.
- Good manners, good habits and punctuality are required to be observed at all times.
- During the working hours, silence has to be maintained while moving around the premises. Running, playing and shouting inside the school premises is not allowed.
- Pupils are not allowed to leave the school premises during the school hours.
- Pupils should not run, shout or push others while moving in the corridors or going up and down the stairs.
- Pupils should follow the instructions of the teachers. They should always obtain teachers' permission before talking to other pupils or moving within the classroom.
- **Students should come only in school uniform whenever they enter the school premise.**
- The school reserves the right to deal with any kind of indiscipline, on the basis of its severity.

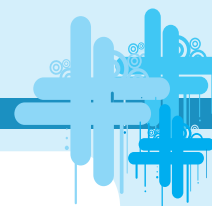


Regularity & Punctuality:

- Attendance on the re-opening day of the new academic year and last working day of the term is mandatory.
- Pupils shall attend all classes regularly.
- Pupils shall be in school five minutes before the first bell.
- Late comers are liable to be sent back home at parents' own risk.
- New admissions are liable to lose their seat if they fail to report within a week from the date of school opening.

Leave:

- Leave of absence shall be granted for valid reason only with prior written application from the parents.
- For one or two days leave, pupils shall fill the leave record given in the school almanac (Page No. 93)
- In case of continued absence due to illness, a Medical Certificate will have to be produced.
- Producing a false Medical Certificate is a serious offence and will invite severe action from the school.
- If a child is suffering from a contagious disease, the school office must be informed of the same within two days by the parents, supported by a Medical Certificate. The child may join school only after the doctor certifies him / her completely fit. A Medical Certificate must be given to the grade teacher on the day of rejoining.
- Students should not attend school if they are suffering from any contagious diseases. They will be sent home if they report before the quarantine period is over.
- As great stress is laid on punctuality and regularity, no retest will be conducted if the student remains absent on the day of assignment/assessment/periodic test.
- If a child is sick he/she should attend the school only after recovery. No early leave will be granted.
- Attendance for all official school functions is compulsory. No request for leave on those days will be entertained.
- Students representing the school for Interschool / District / State / National Level sports will be considered present in the school.
- For absenteeism of more than 2 days, leave letter should be addressed to the Principal and forwarded through the grade teacher to the school office.
- Students will not be allowed in the class without leave letters duly signed by the parents.
- **No early leave will be granted to the pupils except in an emergency or sudden health breakdown. In such cases, parents need to fill an early leave application available in the school office. No telephonic communication from the parents / guardian shall be entertained in this regard.**



Home Assignment:

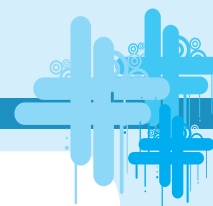
- Home Assignment instills discipline and forms an important part of a student's education since it reinforces the work covered in the classroom.
- All Home Assignments are a part of the Continuous Assessment.
- Pupils shall do all Home Assignments independently. Parents can assist their ward in establishing a regular time table for completing the Home Assignments. Cursive writing for English language and Math tables are daily home assignments.
- Pupils need not write above mentioned home assignment during assessment week.
- Parents are requested to ensure that their ward completes his / her work in time.

Assessment and Evaluation:

- Promotion of a pupil from one grade to another shall be made at the end of the academic year on the basis of his / her performance in Periodic Assessment, Term Examination and Attendance.
- Parents shall be communicated about their wards' performance through the Achievement Record. It shall be shown to the parents at the end of each term during the Parent Teacher Interaction (PTI).
- The school reserves all the rights regarding promotion or detention of a child based on his / her performance throughout the year. Hence the decision of the Principal is final and binding.



School Library:

- Library books will be issued once in a week by the librarian Grade IV onwards
- A book can be further issued for another seven days if there is no demand for it.
- Books are issued only on appointed days.
- Books are to be returned within seven days. If not, a fine will be applicable.
- Perfect silence should be maintained in the library.
- Reference materials like Encyclopedias, Dictionaries and Magazines cannot be borrowed from the library at any time.
- Students must carry their identity card with them at all times and be prepared to show it on request.
- Books picked up from the shelves in the cupboard should be kept back.
- Books should be handled with care. Any damage caused shall be made good by the concerned pupil.
- Books lost or damaged have to be paid for or replaced by the borrower.
- Tearing pages and marking on library books is strictly prohibited.

Parents Teacher Interaction (PTI):

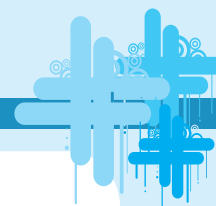

- Food day is celebrated once every month. Parents are requested to send the food items as mentioned in the almanac on the prescribed days (Page no. 30)

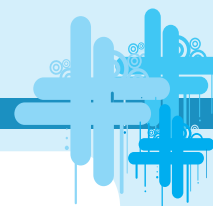
Birthday Celebration

- Pupils can contribute to the school library by donating books with his / her name written on the book.



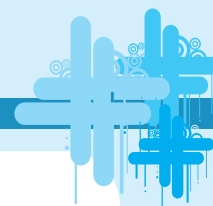
Bus Rules:

- No cancellation of bus service is permissible in the mid session.
- Pupils shall travel on the allotted bus route only.
- School bus shall pick up pupils from the allotted stop only.
- Pupils shall reach ten minutes before the school bus arrives at a given stop.
- Bus shall not wait for pupils beyond the scheduled time.
- Objects of any kind must not be discarded inside or thrown out of the bus.
- All students must occupy seats immediately after boarding the bus and must not move around in the bus.
- Any change in residential address should be intimated through a letter to the grade teacher well in advance.
- Bus facility is meant for pupils only.
- Any damage caused to the school bus by the pupils shall be appropriately recovered from the parents / guardians.
- In case of any unexpected mechanical fault / traffic jam or any other civic problem, bus service can be delayed or cancelled.
- School bus fees are subject to change with the hike of fuel charges & taxes.

- Parents are expected to attend the PTI and all the school functions.
- Parents must ensure that girls wear long black slacks for PE, Yoga and dance practice sessions.
- Parents should encourage the habit of self-study and regularity in reading.
- Parents should inform the grade teacher about any physical, congenital disorder, psychological or emotional problem of their ward to enable the school to take care during any emergency.
- No request for the delivery of books, tiffin boxes, craft materials, etc. will be entertained.
- Parents can communicate their concerns / suggestions to the grade teacher in writing.
- Parents should notify the school in case of change of address or telephone numbers in writing.
